CALL TO ORDER:

The recessed meeting was called to order by Mayor Schmidt. The Mayor stated that all Commissioners were present.

BUSINESS:

BUDGET WORK SESSION – DAY #1:

- **Business Assistance Requests:**

Commissioners and staff discussed the business assistance requests that had been submitted and they reviewed a letter that the Food Bank had sent stating that they were in good shape and were willing to forego the City's donation for 2021. The Commissioners were very appreciative of that gesture from the Food Bank. With little more discussion, Commissioner Meyer made a motion to accept the Food Bank's gesture to reduce their donation for 2021 to zero but re-address their 2022 budget needs, would be reducing Youth Core Ministries to \$150.00 per month and leave all other donations the same for 2021. The motion was seconded by Commissioner Leslie and carried unanimously.

- **Department Superintendent Budget Discussions:**

The Commissioners, City Manager, City Attorney and Finance Director met with the different superintendents during the rest of the day.
